At least half of Americans living with HIV experience homelessness or housing instability following diagnosis. According to the CDC, an estimated 1.2 million people in the United States are living with HIV.

The National AIDS Housing Coalition (NAHC) works to end the HIV/AIDS epidemic by ensuring that persons living with HIV/AIDS have quality, affordable and appropriate housing. Today is World AIDS Day - we commemorate those we have lost and commit to end AIDS.

PREVENTION

PLWHA who are homeless or unstably housed who receive housing assistance are more likely to engage in medical care, reduce risk behaviors, & enjoy better health.



HEALTHCARE

Provision of safe housing to PLWHA at risk of homelessness has been shown to more than double the odds that the individual will have an undetectable viral load & reduces AIDS-related mortality by 80% over 5 years.



CRITICAL

Housing is a proven structural intervention in both treatment and prevention of HIV, part of the National HIV/AIDS Strategy, and is a cost effective intervention

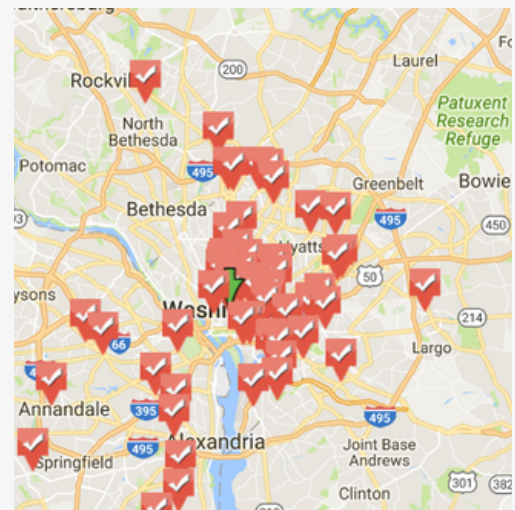
